

High School (8th – 11th) Program Requirements

Attendance

Children who are enrolled in the parish catechetical program are expected to be in attendance for each class session. It is the responsibility of the parent(s) to ensure their presence. Attendance will be taken weekly. There are a total of 8 classes for the 2017-2018.

Missed Classes

Each class session builds on the material covered in preceding classes. If your child misses one class, class material must be made up by the student. It is the student's responsibility to get that missed material from the Catechist. If a student misses more than one class, in addition to making up the missed class work, your child will be asked to write a 5 page research paper on the topic they missed.

Retreat Opportunities

There will be a NET retreat (date to be determined) at St. Eulalia provided this school year for grades 8th – 11th. This retreat **must** be attended by all children enrolled in the catechetical program. The NET retreat will cost an additional \$20 per student.

Spiritual Hours

Each student must also complete 8 hours of a spiritual experience. This can include Eucharist adoration (1st Friday of each month), the rosary (each Monday night in Coudersport 6:30, 1st Fridays in Port), or attend the Stations of the Cross during Lent.

Community Service

Each child needs to complete 10 community service hours for the 2017-2018 school year. Each month, your child will be asked to hand in to the catechist the community service hours they completed that month on the service hours sheet.

Mass Attendance

All children who are enrolled in the religious education program **must** attend Mass each weekend and on Holy Days of obligation.

Arrival and Dismissal

Children are asked to arrive to class on time as it will begin promptly at 12:15. Children will be dismissed at 2:15.

Registration Fee

To help with the many expenses of the religious education program the registration fee is as follows: \$25 per child, \$45 for 2 or more in a family. Please contact Fr. James if you are unable to pay. No one will be denied religious education, due to inability to pay for the registration fee. There will be no refunds.

8 Spiritual Experience Hours

These hours can include Eucharist adoration (1st Friday of each month), the rosary (each Monday night in Coudersport 6:30, 1st Fridays in Port), or attending the Stations of the Cross during Lent (Tuesdays at 7:00pm at St. Eulalia and Fridays at 7:00pm at St. Gabriel).
